**UTOPIA OF V. A. LEVSHIN «THE NEWEST JOURNEY COMPOSED IN THE BELEV CITY». BETWEEN EUTOPIA AND UTOPIA**

The article deals with the utopia of the 18th century – «The Newest Journey, Composed in the Belev City» by V. A. Levshin. The work was not reprinted completely since the 18th century. In connection with this, in literary studies, a tradition to examine primarily the first parts of the work was formed, in which the ideal settlement on the Moon was described, while parts of the story devoted to terrestrial countries were abandoned. Only the American Slavic writer S. L. Baer drew attention to the final fragment of the work, calling it a panegyric utopia. In fact, this observation can be challenged. The last parts were written under censorship pressure, Levshin had no desire to glorify Catherine's Russia. In particular, this can be seen on the quotes from the "Great Mandate of the Empress", which the author cites. Almost all of them describe the goals of the "Mandate" that were declared by Catherine earlier, but which could not be realized. Thus, contrary to the representation of Baer, Levshin became the author of a satirical utopia – dysnomia. Utopia, in which Russian laws are depicted from the negative side.
